Law Enforcement Professional: This program takes students through the ins and outs of day-to-day police activity and introduces students to the complex criminal justice system, interrogation, crime prevention and mitigation.

Homeland Security Specialist: Homeland security professionals address key functions of threat prevention, crisis response, and operations recovery. This program is designed to prepare successful students to work in various Homeland Security agencies at a local, state or federal level.

Victimology: Professionals in this field have the opportunity to work with law enforcement and various social services agencies as well as criminal court systems to make sure victims are properly advocated for and represented in these instances.



Corrections Specialist: This program provides students the basic competencies involved in a position in a corrections facility and/or provide insight for counselors, attorneys and other legal aides additional information and theory related to the US corrections system.

Criminal Investigation Professional: The Criminal Investigation Professional program provides students the basic competencies involved in investigating crimes, the individuals who commit them, and the victims who endure them.

Criminal Justice Professional: The Criminal Justice Professional program provides students the basic competencies involved in criminal justice, legal and investigative ethics, criminal law and procedure as well as juvenile justice and criminal courts.

Criminal Procedure Specialist: Criminal procedure specialists focus on the actions or inactions taken by law enforcement, the legal system and the penal system throughout the investigation and adjudication of a crime.

Juvenile Justice Specialist: This program is designed to prepare students to address questions of crime and punishment, the serious nature of crimes committed and the considerations necessary to take into account regarding the accused.

Paralegal Professional: This program offers an in-depth view of the role of paralegals play within the American legal system. Examining the myriad of skills used by paralegals everyday alongside the typical legal working environment, students will explore the common areas of law in which they'll likely be working, the various ethical considerations that may arise as well as the sources of law they'll reference every day.

Law Office Technology Specialist: Advances in technology are revolutionizing today's legal landscape at a faster pace than ever before. Legal assistants with a focus on technology play one of the most important roles in the legal industry.

Wills, Trusts & Estates Specialist: Explores the legal and ethical requirements necessary to develop and administer an estate plan, taking into account a variety of considerations including statutory intestacy, future interests, and tax implications.

Civil Litigation Specialist: This program explores the process and procedures associated with a civil case. It includes the initial client interview and fact gathering, preparations of pleadings, trial preparation, post-trial procedure, ethical considerations for handling a civil law case, and the application of technology in the preparation and trial of a law suit.

Real Estate Professional: This program takes an interdisciplinary and practice-oriented approach to real estate transactions, covering land transfers, mortgage law, and selected topics such as the structure and law of real estate transactions, including agreements of sale, title and survey matters, leasing, financing, easements, and development rights.

Tort Law Specialist: This program introduces the wide parameters of tort law including how we assign a duty of responsibility to certain actors, assess damages, and determine the distribution of liability for everyday risks.

Contract Specialist: From basic consideration principles of common law through the more detailed and intuitive conclusions of the Uniform Commercial Code (UCC), this program will examine the elements of a valid contract and the process for agreement as well as the different remedies available for breach of contract.

Criminal Law & Procedure Specialist: This program examines key provisions of the 4th, 5th, 6th, and 14th Amendments as they apply to police investigation and interrogation as well as to the circumstances under which defendants are prosecuted.

Family Law Professional: Litigating around the institution of marriage and family that is most personal to individuals, this program law brings to light a number of issues that affect peoples' lives at the deepest level.

Legal Writing Specialist: This program introduces students to legal thought, writing styles and research methods used in the legal profession every day through various methods to solve clients' problems with effective research techniques, accurate and in-depth legal analysis, and clear and concise written and oral communication.
